
As a church member, once you have a login for your church's site, you can access your profile, update your personal and contact information, view and print giving statements, change your privacy settings, and view information for your small groups.




If you received an email inviting you to join the site...

1. If you received an email inviting you to join the site, open it, and click the link.




- 2. The registration page opens in your default web browser.
- 3. Enter your email address. If possible, use the email address your church has on file, but any email address will work. Later, you will use this address to log into the site.
- 4. Also create a password. Enter it twice for confirmation.






Tip: At this point, you might want to write down your password and keep it to yourself, just in case you forget.


5. Click Register.



6. A second message will be sent to your email address.




- 7. Click the link.
- 8. The sign in page opens in your default browser.




9. Enter your password and click **Sign In**.

10. Next, you will see one of two screens:

If the church website has your birthday or phone number on file, you will be asked to enter one of these in order to confirm your identity. For birthday, you just need to enter month and day. Your birth year is never displayed. This is a once-only request. You will not have to verify each time you visit the site.




OR If your church website does not have your birthday or phone number on file, you will be asked to enter some basic information about yourself. Complete the page and click Send Information.






1. Click Register Now.




2. Enter your email address and the password you will use to log in to the site. You might want to jot down the password in case you forget it later.




3. Click Register.



4. A message will be sent to your email address.




- 5. Click the link.
